Region: Cordoba, Priego de Cordoba

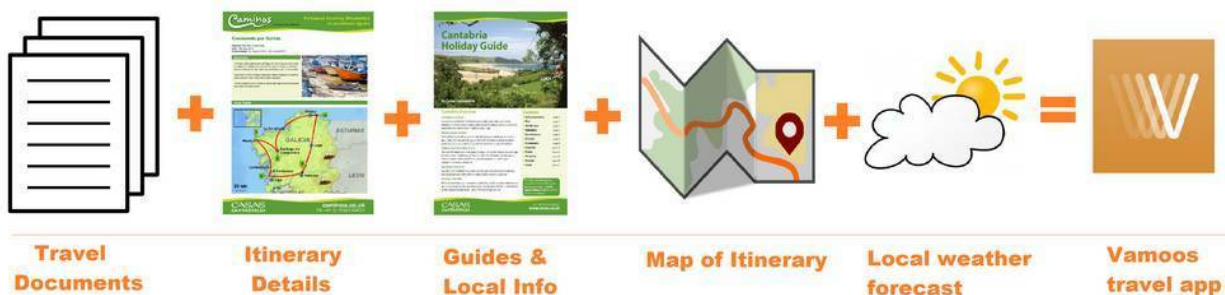
Alcalá la Real, impressive ruins of Moorish fortress town
