# Porto, Douro & Las Beiras PO10

Porto - Douro Valley - Planalto - Serra da Estrela - Coimbra - Aveiro & the Atlantic

A 14 night tour taking in the best of Porto and the Douro Valley before exploring the less well known but fascinating region of Las Beiras from the highlands of Serra da Estrela to the Atlantic coast.

#### Summary

This delightful round trip, full of exciting contrasts and experiences, starts on the Atlantic, in the city of Porto, before forging inland to explore breathtaking scenery of the Douro valley.

From the vineyards we head south into the rugged, boulder-strewn, landscape of the Altaplano with its famous fortress towns then up into the Serra da Estrela, Portugal's highest mountain range - a chance to get back to nature and recharge your batteries.

From there it's westward bound, stopping in historic Coimbra with its prestigious university before ending up in stylish, Art-Nouveau Aveiro, back on the wild Atlantic coast.

Visit the fortress towns of the Planalto – Trancoso, Almeida, Marialva, Castelo Rodrigo... Paleolithic rock-art in the Coa Valley – 5000 petroglyphs – some 22000 years old! Sample the local wines and olive oils of the Beira Alta Visit the Faia Brava nature reserve with wild horses, cattle and large birds of prey Explore the Douro International Nature Park Pop over the border to Spain's Ciudad Rodrigo or even Salamanca

# Medieval charm with pool near the Spanish border

In a privileged position in the tiny walled village of Castelo Rodrigo, with the eponymous castle looming large, this delightful guest house is a treasure and makes the perfect base from which to discover the historic fortress towns of the Planalto, once Portugal's first line of defence against the Castilian and the Moor. 
