
Summary

Elegant, Baroque castle hotel in Porto

Built in 1887 as a private house, this listed building with its imposing tower is wonderfully atmospheric and, being set on a vantage point, commands lovely views of the city. The location is excellent - fairly near the centre (a twenty minute walk) with on site parking and the metro just a short walk a...Read More

Manor house with pool, surrounded by vineyards near coast




