Picos de Europa, the stunning western coast and the wild Western Highlands - all in one delightful trip!



Summary

At the heart of Spain's north coast, Asturias is a mountainous nature-over's paradise with a stunning coastline to match. This tour starts in cider country, in the region's east, between the Picos de Europa National Park and the wonderful beaches of the Dinosaur coast.

From there you'll head up into the western highlands, a land lost in time, where bears, wild deer and capercaillie are still to be found as well as some incredible small wineries producing wines of the highest quality.

The western Asturian coast, with its fishing villages and stunning beaches set against a rich verdant backdrop, is the final stop with plenty of opportunities for adventure and relaxation.

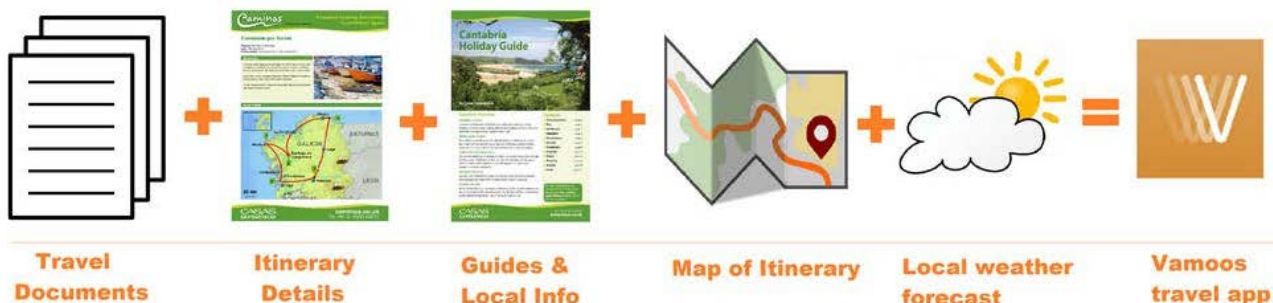
