#### Region: Granada

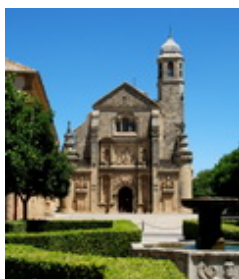
The Alhambra Palace - city of the Nasrid Sultans.

Traditional pottery and fine ceramics thriving today

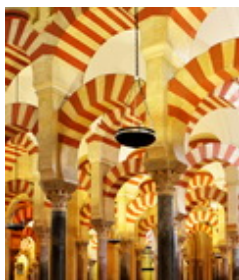
Sierra de Cazorla - biosphere reserve with the source of the Guadalquivir river

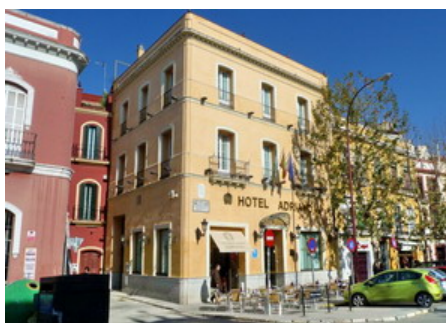


#### Region: Sevilla

Sierra de la Nieves Nature Park.

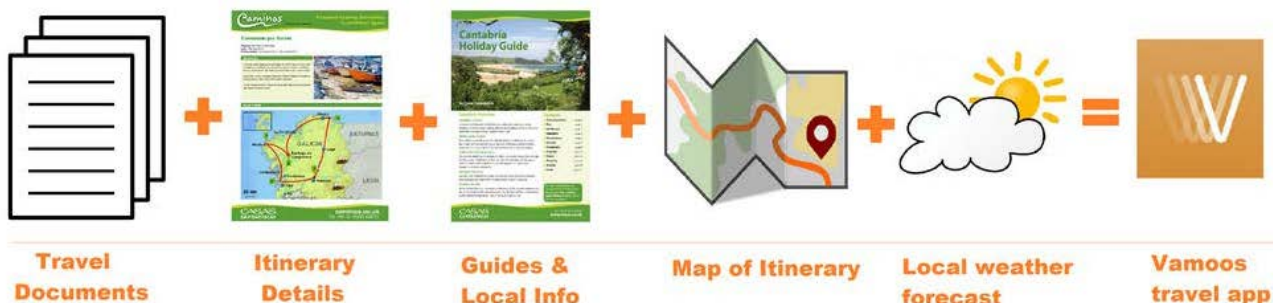
