



PO7 The Porto Run - Santander to Porto

An epic adventure! Cut a swathe right through the heart of Spain to Porto on the Atlantic coast before looping back through Galicia to the northern coast and the Picos de Europa mountains, this route is full of delightful contrasts.

On the way you'll find plenty to explore as you cross and follow the Caminos de Santiago and trace part of Wellington's route from his Peninsular Campaign. You'll find magnificent cities of Burgos, Salamanca, Porto and Santiago and rural delights of the Douro Valley, the Asturian coast and the Picos de Europa mountains.

There is a lounge and breakfast room/bar (Santillana del Mar, about 5 minutes' walk away, has a good choice of restaurants).



Configured for iPhone and Android, for use on both tablets and mobile phones.

In the app you will find:
