Charming Moura, its Moorish quarter, ancient castle, delightful gardens and olive oil museum.. Fascinating Beja, capital of the Baixo Alentejo at the heart of the "Golden Plain" – on the map since the Iron

This fine 17th century listed building is located in the lovely, old town of Moura, in the southern Alentejo region. Originally a convent, it was converted into a hotel in 1900. The building, of significant historical, architectural and artistic value, has been recently refurbished while carefully retaining its ambience of the past. Some features stand out in this unpretentious building: beautifully tiled facade, the high ornate ceilings, balu...Read More
