

Starting in Northern Navarra, this route will take you into the high mountains of Huesca, the dramatic desert landscape of Las Bardenas, through Navarran wine-country to La Rioja and on to Bilbao.

Straddling the ancient kingdoms of Castile, Navarra and Aragon, borders hard fought in medieval times, here you'll find some of Spain's finest castles and Romanesque churches as well as some of its best modern architecture among the vines in La Rioja and, of course, in Bilbao's iconic Guggenheim Museum.

Throughout the trip you'll enjoy great walking, wonderful scenery, fine local wines and gastronomy and, of course, a warm Spanish welcome.

This delightful 4-star, chalet-style hotel sits in harmony with the mountains of the Valle de Tena, just 30 km from the ski resorts and 35km from the entrance to the truly awesome Ordesa National Park.

Opened in 1950 this delightful guest house, set in the village of Isaba at the head of the Roncal Valley in the Navarran Pyrenees, has been recently renovated to a high standard and is the perfect base to discover the charms of this rugged yet beautiful region.

The 20 fully-equipped rooms all have en-suite bathrooms and are decorated in a surprisingly modern style, making a feature where possible of the building's historical charm.

The village has good amenities, including a good public swimming pool and several restaurants and Ochagavia, the Irati forest and the gorges of Arbayun and Lumbiers are all within easy reach.

This fine 17th century mansion, in the centre of the picturesque, medieval village of Cuzcurrita del Rio Tiron, in La Rioja Alta, has been recently restored but certainly has a history!

Originally the home of a wealthy family, in the 1920's and 30's, the building was put to use as a bakery, theatre and cinema before, during the Civil War, being occupied by Italian troops who passed on their pasta recipes to the locals.

The present owners, Laura and Jose Angel, the most welcoming and attentive of hosts, fell in love with the place an restored the building into the very special small hotel it is today.


